

## Full Rules – Contest 1 (7/12-8/1):

### Dunkin' Donuts Community Champions - Contest Rules

#### How to Enter for a Chance to Win

The contest/promotion runs from July 12<sup>th</sup> - August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010. There is one (1) way to enter:

In 250 words or less, tell us about a worthy certified 501(c)(3) charitable cause or organization in your town that is deserving of a little extra support. If your entry is selected as the official Community Champion, the Program Sponsor, Dunkin' Brands, Inc. as Master Servicer and DB Adfund Administrator LLC ("Dunkin Donuts" or "Sponsor") will arrange for a donation of \$5,000 to this cause or organization. In addition, for helping us to recognize the Community Champion, Dunkin' Donuts will award the person who submitted the winning entry with Free Coffee for a Year. All entries must be filled out completely to be considered a valid entry.

One winner will be selected on or about August 2, 2010 and will be notified by phone and/or mail. The winning entry will be selected in the sole discretion of a panel of judges selected by Dunkin Donuts. Judging will be 50% on the mission of the organization and 50% on your articulation of the benefits the cause or organization is delivering to the community. **Note:** only the individual who submits the actual winning entry selected by the judges will win Free Coffee for a Year. Other entrants who nominate the same cause or organization will NOT be eligible for Free Coffee for a Year.

#### Prize

The prize consists of :

- (1) a \$5,000 donation arranged by Dunkin' Donuts through the Dunkin' Donuts and Baskin-Robbins Community Foundation to the organization or cause identified in the winning entry.
- (2) Free Coffee for a Year, to be provided in the form of Dunkin' Donuts Cards in the total amount of \$1,000.

All entrants must be at least 18 years old and legal residents of the United States, living or working in the total survey area (as defined by Arbitron) of WROR ("Station"). **All nominated causes and organizations must be (or be affiliated with) a charitable organization qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal Revenue Code, and may be required to show proof of their tax status before receiving the donation.** Employees (including their immediate families and members of the same household) of Sponsor, Greater Media Boston, and their respective affiliates, and advertising and promotional agencies are not eligible to participate in this contest. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents and legal guardians, children and legal wards, grandparents, and grandchildren, including "in-laws." Limit one entry per person; multiple entries will disqualify the entrant. Void where prohibited.

#### Release

### **Taxes**
